Guidelines

- 1. Alpha Gamma Sigma Fraternity, Beta chapter, at the University of Missouri-Columbia, strives to seek out talented and goal oriented young men. Our scholarship program allows us to do so by giving high-school seniors the opportunity to showcase their accomplishments and future aspirations through this application. 2 applicants will be chosen and receive a \$500 dollar scholarship to be used toward college tuition, board, or any other educational expenses. One of the scholarships will be awarded to someone pursuing a degree in the College of Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources, and the other will be awarded to any major.
- 2. Applicants must be a high school male student, and must have been a full-time student in the 2015-2016 school years.
- 3. Applicants must plan to attend the University of Missouri-Columbia.
- 4. Hard copies of this application must be postmarked and returned via U.S. Postal Service, Federal Express, or UPS by March 15, 2016 to Alpha Gamma Sigma, Attn: Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship, PO Box 190, Columbia, MO 65205. - 5. Include with your application an official high school transcript for proof of GPA and enrollment.
- 6. Letters of recommendation are not required but will be reviewed if included with your scholarship application.
- 7. Applications will be reviewed by the Alpha Gamma Sigma executive board of members and recipients will be notified via mail by or before August 1, 2016. A check will be mailed then by October 17, 2016 for the recipients educational expenses.
