<u>Personal Letter by Applicant</u>: Letter should discuss background, career goals, financial need, and commitment to chosen field of study. Not to exceed two typed or computer generated pages. No additional materials will be accepted.

Extracurricular Activities and/or Honors Received: Attach list

<u>Letters of Recommendation:</u> Three (3) letters of recommendation required. Each limited to one typed or computer generated page. Additional pages or letters will not be accepted. Letters should include discussion of the following:

- 1. Scholastic Ability
- 2. Character references
- 3. Work-related experience
