- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen. Preferred consideration will be given to applicants living within Septagon's business and employment areas.
- Application materials must be delivered or postmarked by 5 p.m., March 24, 2017. Applications postmarked after the deadline will not be considered.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail before May 1.
- Scholarship payments will be sent directly to the university/college to be applied to the student's account. Payments will be made by Aug. 15.
