Kaleb Libbert Memorial Scholarship

We are giving to the Cole R-1 School District \$1,000.00 - these funds are to be held by said school District. The money therefrom to be used for granting of an onetime annual college scholarship to an applicant, who graduated from the Cole R-1 School District, and said scholarship to be upon the following terms and conditions:

- The scholarship fund shall be designated as the Kaleb Libbert Memorial Scholarship Fund, and the scholarship award therefrom shall be known as the Kaleb Libbert Memorial Scholarship.
- 2. The recipient of the onetime annual scholarship shall be selected by a committee composed of the following persons: Cole R-1 High School Principal, Cole R-1 High School Counselor, Cole R-1 High School Secretary, Cole R-1 High School Athletic Director and the Cole R-1 High School Resource Director. Each of these five persons will have an equal vote.
- 3. In the event that any of the above said committee members could not serve on the committee for any reason, the Cole R-1 High School Principle will designate a representative to take their place for the current year.
- 4. Beginning with the 2016 graduating class, a one onetime scholarship of \$1,000.00 shall be awarded annually to a Cole R-1 graduating senior that has met all the criteria.
- 5. The actual scholarship monetary award will be a check written after proof of enrollment. Should the recipient not be able to fulfill this criterion, their monetary award shall remain in the corpus for awarding of future scholarships.
- At graduation exercises, the individual will be presented with a plaque of recognition for receipt of the scholarship.

- \* Applicants must have a GPA 3.5 or higher and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- \* The one time Scholarship fund of \$1,000 will be paid to either the college or to the applicant, whichever the applicant prefers. The applicant will be required to submit their student Id number along with the college information to the Cole County R-1 School District.
- \* Applications must be endorsed by the school district's guidance counselor attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. The foundation strongly suggests that Cole R-1 High School presents this opportunity to the strongest candidates that match the criteria and who can really benefit from receiving the funds.

### Student Essay Requirement:

Submit a 1 page essay or more describing how volunteer or community service has shaped who you are today and what community service has taught you. Also, discuss in your essay about any challenges or obstacles you have dealt with and overcome in life and how this will help you succeed in college and beyond. Describe your intended area of study, your career path and how you feel it will contribute to the society.
