## **Missouri Fastest Growing Occupations**

Missouri is projected to have a net increase of more than 182,000 jobs between 2020 and 2022. This higher-than-usual job increase is due to the projected recovery from the job losses suffered during the COVID-19 pandemic. Of the top 20 occupations in the state with the fastest growth rate, eight are in the *Personal Care and Service* major occupation group, and seven are in the *Food Preparation and Serving Related* group. These occupations are concentrated in industries that experienced major employment declines during the pandemic, but are projected to recover, at least partially, and have high rates of employment growth over the next two years.
