Missouri Top Openings

Missouri is projected to have more than 375,000 total job openings each year between 2019 and 2021. Total openings comprise growth openings, exit openings, and transfer openings. Growth openings are the result of an occupation growing between the base year and the projected year. Exit openings occur when a worker leaves the workforce entirely, such as retirement. Transfer openings occur when a worker leaves their occupation for a different one. Of the top 20 occupations with the most total openings, five are in the *Office and Administrative Support* major occupation group. *Registered Nurses, Construction Laborers*, and *General and Operations Managers* are occupations that are projected to have high numbers of total openings as well as average wages higher than the state average for all occupations.
