- 1. Student must be a high school graduate or alumni of Eldon or Russellville or Eugene High School.
- 2. Student must have exhibited good character in school and community.
- 3. Student must exhibit scholastic promise and potential for completion of college.
- 4. Student will continue their higher education in secondary schooling, an accredited college, or a university as a part-time or full-time student, and be under the age of 25.
- 5. Student cannot be related by blood or marriage to any member of the Selection Committee.
- 6. Student must have demonstrated willingness to work to contribute to their education and help themselves financially.
- 7. Applicant should include in the essay their connection to the Town of Olean.
- 8. Recipients will have the opportunity to re-apply for the scholarship if the recipient earns at least the minimum number of credits required to be a part-time or full-time student. The recipients will be considered with all other applicants and therefore renewal is not automatic.

Other Criteria:

- 1. Payment of scholarship will be made at the beginning of the school year to the recipient and college.
- 2. The Selection Committee will choose the applicant and/or applicants application and \$1000.00 will be awarded to that applicant.
- 3. Decisions of the Selection Committee will be final and will be made in the collective and absolute uncontrolled discretion of the member of the Selection Committee. No member of the Selection Committee shall have any personal liability for decisions made in good faith by the Selection Committee.
- 4. The Selection Committee shall immediately deliver one copy of the record of their deliberations and award (including copies of the applications made to them for the scholarship) to the Olean Community Scholarship Committee at P.O. Box 11, Olean, MO 65064.
